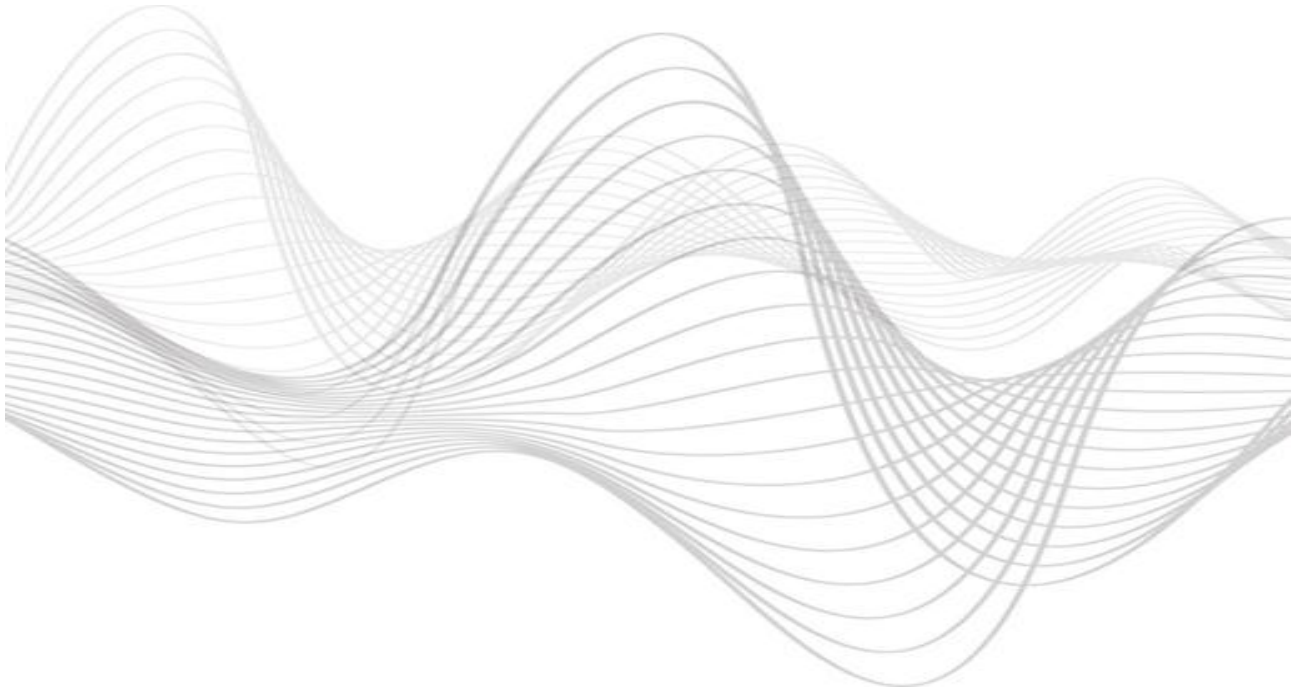


SALT 2012
